Membership

At the end of June, 2019 (the most recent count available), CMA's membership totaled 274 (192 professional, 80 student, 2 life members), an increase of 14% from June of the previous year.

General Finances

As of 10/31/19 Net Assets were \$86,592.40, an increase of more than \$11,500 from the end of 2018. This does not account for funds spent later in the year (primarily for the Annual Meeting activities budgeted at \$4,000). Mid-year the Ames/Distinguished Service quasi-endowment was worth \$11,888.39 (up \$234.89 from last year) and the Student Travel Award quasi-endowment was worth \$27,949.84 (up \$552.23 from last year). These two quasi-endowments do not presently meet our award needs as we annually give out \$1,000 for the two student travel awards plus \$500 for our new CMA book award. I recommend creating a distinct account to fund the CMA book award.

Museum Anthropology Journal

The editorial budget for *Museum Anthropology* in 2019 continued to be modest at \$11,316. Under Lea McChesney's editorship, the University of New Mexico provided fantastic institutional support for the journal (budgeted to be worth \$38,730 in 2019). To support our incoming co-editors Emily W. Stokes-Rees (Syracuse University) and Phaedra Livingstone (Centennial College, Toronto) the board voted to increase the *Museum Anthropology* editorial budget to \$15,420 in 2020. There still remains \$1,333 left in the *Museum Anthropology* 2019 budget.

CMA Biennual Conference "Museums Different" in Santa Fe, NM, September 19-21, 2019 Revenues were \$80,083 (from registration (\$16,985), sponsoring institutions (\$11,300), CMA contribution (\$10,000) and NMAI (\$41,798.26)) and expenditures were \$76,094. There were 158 registrants with 52 Indigenous participant registrations, travel and accommodation scholarships, and 13 student registration scholarships.
