## Council for Museum Anthropology Treasurer's Report 10/18/21

## Membership

At the end of September 2021 CMA's membership totaled 140 (35 professional, 85 students, 16 retired, 4 sustaining) up from March 2021's 124 numbers but decidedly down from our decade average of 288.

This is clearly due to the pandemic, the cancelling of the 2020 conference in St. Louis and the confusion about the hybrid AAAs in Baltimore this year. On a positive note, you can see the leap in student numbers (from 57 last year to 85 this year, which I think probably has to do with Kristin Otto's mentoring workshops even though it was not a requirement for students to be either AAA or CMA members in order to participate!

## General Finances

On September 30, 2021 our Net Assets were \$77,695.07 This is up from this time last year when we had \$60,204.40.

On September 30, 2021, the CMA Student Travel Awards quasi-endowment (QE502) was worth \$53,571.19 earning us \$1,580.68 this year (up from 2020's value of \$51,474.05).

On September 30, 2021 the CMA Ames/Distinguished Service quasi-endowment (QE501) was worth \$13,006.04 earning us \$383.76 this year (up from 2020's value of \$12,496.89.)

## Museum Anthropology Journal

The editorial budget for *Museum Anthropology* in 2021 was \$10,400, the majority went unspent by editor Dr. Phaedra Livingstone. The 2022 journal budget is \$15,700 bulked up to support our incoming editor Dr. Hannah Turner (UBC).
